1 Warwickshire Qualification.

Some athletes residing within our boundaries choose to identify with other Counties for good and substantial reasons. However we warmly invite athletes with a Warwickshire Qualification, residing inside or outside our boundaries to compete for our County Medals and represent our Teams.

Remember that for athletics Warwickshire means both present Warwickshire i.e. Nuneaton and North Warwickshire, Stratford, Warwick, Leamington and South Warwickshire and the Rugby area plus the towns and cities which used to be in Warwickshire before the City Councils were created in 1974 i.e. Coventry, Birmingham, Sutton Coldfield, Solihull and Coleshill.

To qualify for the County an athlete must have been born in it, or, have been living in it for 9 months, or, be serving in the armed force stationed for 9 months in it. It is possible to qualify for three different Counties but an athlete cannot switch mid season having competed for one of them. The location of the Club at which the athlete is a member is not relevant.

2 Officiating.

The Health and Safety course in Nuneaton in early June saw 29 participants. We will keep you in the picture re opportunities for Officials and Administrators. Meanwhile Margery Ewington (02476 314990) and Leonnie Lightfoot (West Mids Region 07824 302935) are always available with advice.

3 Road Running – attention race promoters, officials and athletes.

From April 2008 a number of rule changes, particularly in respect to Race Permits, came into operation. We strongly urge promoters to become fully acquainted with Rule 204 as well as Rules 207, 208 and 209.

No new rule has been framed as yet for the wearing of IPods and other earpiece devices but there is unanimity amongst senior Race Referees in the County that they constitute a danger if worn on open roads during competition. It is therefore suggested to Race Promoters that athletes are advised via entry forms and notices at Declaration that these devices should not be worn.

Mike Doyle, Warwickshire's valuable Permit Secretary hopes Promoters of events held in the County will apply for their UKA licence well before the race. In the light of previous experiences he wishes to emphasise that times set in any road race without a licence/permit cannot be recognised for records at any level.

4 Future Meetings.
The WCAA AGM will be held on Wednesday 26th November 2008 at Coventry Godiva Harriers HQ. In between AGMs there are occasional General Meetings but the day to day business of the County is conducted through regular formal meetings of the WCAA Officers (and informal meetings and conversations). If you would like the County's Officers to act upon something then let one of them know and it will be treated very soon or at the next Officers meeting at the latest.

5 Development.
Two rounds of the U11 Track and Field League completed and further lessons learned. Thanks to Solihull and Rugby for their promotions and for including relays. The last of the series will be held on Wednesday 27th August at Stratford (Stratford High School) and Coventry (Lyng Hall School).
