The event was held at Bedford in reasonable weather, but was poorly attended by Warwickshire athletes: only 4 men took part. The men's and women's teams finished 9th in their respective groups, with the highlight being a win in the 3,000 metres walk for Godiva's Brendan Boyce.

It is disappointing that after staging County Track and Field and Cross-Country Championships with lots of competitors that only 4 men were willing to represent the County at Bedford.
